

# Requirements disposal large household waste \*

Waste that is too large or too heavy for an (underground) container or that does not belong in a (underground) container, you must bring it to the separation station yourself or leave it by appointment to pick up.

## Bring to the separation station

**You cannot make an appointment for bulk waste for the following items.**

Asbestos, car tires, concrete, sleepers, fire extinguishers, small chemical waste (KCA), bicycles, turf, paper, tiles, roof tiles, garden soil, (flat) glass, textiles, electrical appliances.

For the disposal of large quantities of rubble, construction and demolition waste, etc., there are various container companies in the region.

## Rules for pick up large household waste

- Place your large household waste on the street on the day of the pick up appointment before 7.30 or earliest the evening before after 8 p.m.
- Bind loose materials of the same type together (planks, rods or pruning waste such as branches) into manageable bundles, with a maximum length of 2 meters.
- Because large household waste is usually collected by a car with a crane, the waste must be easily accessible; at least 1.5 meters free all around.
- Do not place your large waste next to our underground containers, on your own property, in a driveway, at a lamppost, against a fence or hedge, behind cars, near or under a tree, under a balcony or against the wall.
- When making an appointment, please provide a clear specification of what you would like to have picked up and name the items individually.
- Waste that is not presented according to the requirements will not be collected by the GAD

## Large household waste

- Various household items, no longer than 2 meters. Doors or cabinet parts may remain intact, but may not contain glass, mirrors or lamps.
- Planks, rods, laminate, and carpet bound together into manageable bundles with a maximum length of 2 meters.

## Large garden waste

- Large garden waste consists of organic material and is collected separately from other large household waste. It is mainly pruning waste too large for the green container.
- Bulky garden waste is composted. It must not be contaminated with other materials.
- Bind loose materials such as branches together into manageable bundles, with a maximum length of 2 meters and up to a maximum of 15 kilos.
- Fence parts, concrete mesh, rose arches, sleepers, garden furniture or, for example, planters are not garden waste. Make an appointment for these products for large households

waste or take it to the recycle centre yourself.

- tree trunks are often heavier than 15 kilos. You can make an appointment for this for large household waste or you can drop it off yourself at our recycle centre.
- Stones, tiles, gravel, garden soil and sand also are not garden waste. We will not pick this up. You can bring this to our recycle centre.

## **Cost**

Dispose of your large household waste is free of charge. You can bring it to one of our recycling centers or make an appointment for pick up. Both are free when the large household waste is no more than 1m<sup>3</sup> per fortnight (1 x 1 x 1 m).

If you dispose of more than 1m<sup>3</sup> at the time, the GAD will charge you. The maximum of pick up of 3 m<sup>3</sup> will cost €45 per extra m<sup>3</sup>, for a maximum total amount of €90.

## **Commercial waste**

GAD is responsible for the collection of household waste. We do not collect commercial waste. For this you need a contract with a commercial collector.
